What is the WFSGI Pledge?

The WFSGI Pledge is a tool to ensure that GAA/Camogie Association Licensed products are manufactured in compliance with the WFSGI Code of Conduct outlining internationally recognized labour standards and basic environmental requirements.

How can I obtain the WFSGI Pledge?

To launch the Pledge application process, please contact the WFSGI by email pledge@wfsgi.org. The WFSGI Team will provide you with detailed information about all the requirements. Briefly, there are three steps to take:

STEP 1 PLEDGE FORM

For each Pledge request WFSGI will provide you with a uniquely numbered Pledge form, which has to be duly completed, signed by both the GAA/Camogie Association Licensee (Applicant) and its manufacturer on every page of the document, and returned to the WFSGI.

STEP 2 SOCIAL AUDIT REPORT

The Licensee (Applicant) will provide a social audit report proving its manufacturer's compliance with the WFSGI Code of Conduct. The report must:

- Be not older than one year;
- Issued by an auditing company, which is a member of the Association of Professional Social Compliance Auditors (APSCA) (the current list of all accredited service providers can be found at [APSCA's Official Website](#);
- Cover all principles outlined in the WFSGI Code of Conduct;
- Issued in English;
- Be owned (paid) by the GAA/Camogie Association Licensee (Applicant) or its Manufacturer.

STEP 3 PAYMENT OF THE PLEDGE SERVICE FEE

After the WFSGI confirms that both the Pledge form and the social audit report meet the WFSGI Pledge requirements, they will issue the invoice for the Pledge service fee:

- WFSGI Members: the service fee is 1,000 CHF for each Pledge request.
- Other companies: the service fee is 1,500 CHF for every Pledge request.
- The fee is payable in full upon the receipt of the invoice.
- The WFSGI will only issue the Pledge after the payment has been credited to their account.

After the requirements outlined above are fulfilled, the WFSGI will issue the Pledge and forward all the documents directly to the GAA/Camogie Association. The Pledge will be valid for one year and will have to be renewed on annual basis.
